

The Bearded Bison Eatery & Ale House sits in a historic old brick building, with records dating back as far as 1867.



In 1884, it became a drug and dry goods store and by 1891, the original Post Office serving the Berlin area moved into the back of the building. It continued that way until 1911 when O'Connell's Clothing store moved into the space from across the street, where they operated until 1986. The Bearded Bison hopes to continue this great history and remain a staple in the Berlin community for years to come. The Bearded Bison Eatery & Ale House is the newest addition to the restaurant and bar scene in historic downtown Berlin, serving contemporary American fare for lunch and dinner with quality ingredients. They even have a 65-inch LED television to watch your favorite sporting event.
